Session 1– MUSICAL THEATRE, June 19-22, 2023 (Grades K-12)- \$50 per participant

Join us for four fun filled days of singing and dancing as our instructors introduce you to the world of musical theatre! Participants will be split up, based on age, and learn a song and dance routine and perform it in front of an audience on the last day of camp.

Session 2– BEGINNING PERFORMANCE, June 26-29, 2023 (Grades K-12)- \$50 per participant

If you are new to the stage, or looking for extra stage techniques, this four day camp is designed just for you. Learn the basics of the stage through physicality, emotions, and facial expressions and perform a play at the end of camp in front of an audience.

Session 3– ADVANCED YOUTH THEATRE, July 10-14, 2023 (Grades 6-12)- \$100 per participant

This five day camp will help our advanced performers learn new theatre techniques, how to help channel emotions, and how to develop more depth to create stronger characters on stage. Participants from this camp will be going to Ashland on July 13 to watch Oregon Shakespeare Festival's Romeo and Juliet, as well as getting a back stage tour of the theatre. This trip is 8 AM-6PM.

All participants from this camp will need to approved by the instructor.

1. I represent that I am at least 18 years of age and am otherwise competent to enter into the agreement.
2. I understand and acknowledge that there may be risks associated with my child's participation in this camp. I expressly assume all risks associated with my child's participation in the camp, including, without limitation, any and all risks of personal injury or property damage. If our application is accepted, I agree to sign a liability waiver for my child.
3. I accept total responsibility for any and all medical expenses that could arise out of my child's participation in the camp.
4. As a condition of participation, it is understood and authorized that photos, video and/or audio may be taken of camp participants. It is also understood and agreed that said content may be used by UACT for promotional materials, marketing collateral, and online media.
5. These camps are for students interested in theatre and should not be used in any way for childcare services. Your child is expected to participate in all activities that the camp provides.
6. Students may not deface or vandalize the facility in any way. Vandalism will result in suspension from the camp and additional fees to cover the damages.
7. It is understood that students are to behave in a polite and respectful manner while at the UACT Youth Summer Theatre Camps. Profanity, verbal disrespect, name calling, etc. will not be tolerated. UACT IS A BULLY FREE ZONE. Also, rough-housing of any kind is strictly prohibited and we ask that the students not run while in the theatre. When in the theatre, the students must listen and follow instructions exactly. Students are not allowed to bring any kind of weapon to the camp (this includes Swiss army knives, etc.) and are asked not to bring other electronic devices which might become damaged, lost or stolen. It is understood that UACT, its staff and volunteers, are absolutely not responsible for any damaged, lost or stolen items which the students may elect to bring with them to the UACT camps. Parents or students may not harass, insult or otherwise abuse UACT camp staff, volunteers, and students.
8. I understand if my child violates the rules and guidelines of the camp, they will be asked to leave the program immediately with no refund.
